



2023 Christmas Program Eligibility

Registration of all Christmas Programs begins Monday October 30th until Friday December 8th.

A person is eligible for assistance at Christmas if he/she:

1. Lives in Delta; &
2. Is on a limited income, defined as:
 - a. Income Assistance (BC Benefits)
 - b. EI
 - c. Senior – receiving GIS
 - d. Total Family Income below the Low Income Cut-Offs as defined by Statistics Canada (see chart below)

**To qualify as Low Income, you must meet the following criteria:
Income interest earned is no more than \$1,000 per adult per year.
RRSP contribution is no more than \$1,000 per family per year.**

Family income meets Low Income Cut-Off (LICO) figures below. *

Individual:	\$29,380
Family of 2:	\$36,756
Family of 3:	\$44,966
Family of 4:	\$54,594
Family of 5:	\$61,920
Family of 6:	\$69,835
Family of 7+:	\$77,751

*Individuals with a Disability Tax Credit certificate: your maximum allowable income to qualify is increased by the amount of your Disability tax credit.

**Children must be 18 years of age or under to receive toys/gifts.
Only 2 family members per household will be admitted to the Toy Depot and absolutely no children will be allowed, so please arrange for child care early.
Please let us know ahead of time if a translator will be required.**
