Better at Home Information

Deltassist Better at Home helps seniors remain independent by providing drives to medical appointments, light housekeeping, and phone shopping services to seniors in Delta.

Fees for service are on a sliding scale based on income, which may include free services for low income seniors (if subsidy is available).

To qualify for the program seniors must be 65 years of age or older, live in Delta and have health issues that preclude you from maintaining independence in your home.

Better at Home is funded by the Province of British Columbia and managed by the United Way of the Lower Mainland, and is part of a collection of services Deltassist provides to help seniors live independently and remain connected to the community.

Light Housekeeping

Housekeeping services are delivered by contracted Home Support Agencies. Cleaning supplies must be provided by the senior. Housekeeping may include vacuuming, washing dishes, cleaning counters, dusting, mopping floors, clean bathroom, change linens, laundry (only if in suite or close by).

Phone Shopping Program

Volunteers will take your order by phone for shopping at Safeway (ND) or Save-On-Foods (Tsawwassen). Groceries are delivered free of charge with a minimum order of \$50.

Volunteer Drive program

Volunteers provide seniors with transportation to medical, dental and wellness appointments. The cost for this service is based on the distance of the trip. Parking fees are the responsibility of the senior.

To Apply:

Please contact us by phone or email. We will then schedule an intake to complete the registration process. At that point you will be asked to provide general information and your income from the previous year (if you wish to be considered for subsidized services).
